

Nicolas Levrat

Nicolas Levrat is since 2001 a full Professor at the Law Faculty of the University of Geneva. He was before a Professor at Université Libre de Bruxelles.

He has been the Director of the European Institute at the University of Geneva from 2007 to 2012. He is the founder and current Director of the Global Studies Institute, inaugurated in 2012 at the University of Geneva. The GSI currently hosts 1'600 students and about 90 researchers. He participates in numerous research projects, financed by European and Swiss funds.

He is since member of the Board of the European PhD School and Joint doctorate programme on Globalisation, Europe and Multilateralism.

He is President of the scientific Committee of the Geneva Human Rights Week.

He is co-director of the Geneva Transformative Governance Lab.

He is the author more than 100 scientific articles and about 20 books. His research and publications are quite eclectic, mostly concerned with Federalism, European integration and the structure of European legal orders, International Organizations and human rights, Computational Diplomacy, Minority & Peoples rights, the role of Local and Regional Governments in International Relations, Cross-border cooperation, the impact of globalisation on democratic institutions.
